Minutes

Call to Order; 7:00pm followed by Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call: Present: Joe Sova - Midland County Drain Commissioner Chairman, Mike Wood - Jerome Township, Jeanette Snyder - Midland County Commissioner, Carl Hamann - Village of Sanford, and Bill Gebo - Member at Large.

Old Business: Report from Four Lakes representative on SLIB funds used for shore line stabilization. Reported that project is nearly completed and came in under budget.

New Business: Bottom Lands. Don Zackett gave a presentation on spraying bottom land growth.

Edenville Township has approved Professional Lake Management (PLM) to apply for the permit which covers the entire lake.

Carl Hamann is against spraying, he says mowing is the way to go.

Mike Wood agrees that the SLIB should paying for half the NPDES permit that Edenville applied for.

Mike Wood thinks that mowing should be done prior to any spray application.

Bill Gebo made a motion to reimburse Edenville Township for half the cost of the NPDES permit (\$2,500.00), seconded by Jeanette Snyder. Roll call vote: Yea – Sova, Snyder, Gebo Nay – Hamann. Motion carried.

Bill Gebo made a motion to hire Fahey, Schultz (FSBR) to guide the lake board in reinstating an assessment and to have a legal review done of the bylaws, seconded by Carl Hamann.

Motion carried.
