

The Midland County Health Department has scheduled our flu clinics for 2019. The first clinic is scheduled for September 23<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m.-12 p.m. and 1 p.m.-4 p.m. Two clinics are scheduled in October, on the 10<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. and on the 24<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. We'll have two more clinics in November, on the 7<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. and the 21<sup>st</sup> from 9 a.m.-1:00p.m. More dates will be added based on demand. All clinics will take place in the Board of Commissioner's room of the County building. We can vaccinate anyone 6 months of age or older. We may have a limited supply of FluMist this year. We have all other injectable forms of the flu vaccine (except Intradermal) including high dose flu for Seniors. We are able to bill BC/BS-commercial and Medicare; Aetna-commercial and Medicare, Connectcare, McLaren, Medicaid, Medicare and Medicare Plus Blue. The cost of the flu vaccine is \$40.00 but people paying at the time of service will be given a \$5 discount. Cash, checks or credit cards\* can be accepted as payment. Some children may be eligible for further discounts. Flu shots are also available by appointment in our immunization clinic by calling 989-832-6665.

**As of 2017, we have a new credit card system. The system will add a surcharge of \$1.00 for anything up to a \$35.00 charge or a 2.75% surcharge for anything over \$35.00**
