

VISITOR RULES

**Inmates are responsible for remembering their own visit.
Staff will not remind them.**

Rules for Visitors

- 1. NO TANK TOPS, HALTER TOPS OR LOW CUT SHIRTS!!!**
- 2. NO VISITORS UNDER 17 ARE ALLOWED.**
- 3. You must have a valid picture I.D. with you at EVERY visit.
(Driver license or State I.D.)**
- 4. If you have been incarcerated in the Midland County Jail within the last 30 days, you are ineligible to visit.**
- 5. You must be on inmate's visitor list. It is the INMATE'S responsibility to let YOU know when their visitation time is and who is on their list. The inmate may put 4 names on their visitor list. Only 2 of the 4 visitors on the list may visit each week.**
- 6. You need to arrive 15-20 minutes prior to the scheduled visit time in order to check in. Visitation will be denied if visitors arrive late, regardless of excuse or reason.**
- 7. You must stay the entire 20-minute visit. If you leave before the visit is done, you will NOT be allowed back in or to visit again.**
- 8. Your visit will begin when the inmate picks up his/her end of the receiver, and will automatically shut off after 20 minutes.**
- 9. During each visit, a Deputy will do a random walk-through of the visitation room to ensure all visitors are conducting themselves appropriately and respectfully.**
- 10. If you are caught with your feet on the walls, you will be expelled.**

Rules for Visitors

**NO personal belongings allowed in visitation room.
Lockers are provided behind you at your expense of a
quarter (25¢).**

We are not responsible for any items left unlocked.

**NO electronic devices of any kind
NO coats, hats, purses, food, keys, hoodies,
halter tops or tank tops
Pockets must be empty**

**Respect other visitors –
NO FOUL LANGUAGE and SPEAK SOFTLY**

**DRESS APPROPRIATELY Per Visitation Deputy

****Visitors 17****

- 1. If you are still in school, you must have a letter (on school letterhead) signed by the principal and your parents stating that you have permission to visit at the jail.**
- 2. If you have graduated, you must have proof.**
- 3. If you are home schooled, you must have proof and you must visit with an adult who is also on the inmate's list.**
- 4. If you dropped out of school, you must have a letter from the school you dropped out of (on letterhead) with appropriate signatures.**
- 5. If you are married, proof of marriage certificate must be shown with one of the above.**
