Pursuant to Michigan State Law, P.A. 339 of 1919, all dogs are required to be licensed by age **four months**. If you are a new resident of Midland County or you acquire a dog older than four (4) months, a license must be obtained within 30 days to avoid a delinquent fee of \$20.

A valid rabies vaccination is required to purchase or renew a license. In Midland County, dog licenses expire the last day of the month the rabies vaccine expires. A one-year license is typically issued when a rabies vaccine is only valid for one year, and a three year license is recommended if the rabies is valid for three full years.
